2021 Arizona State Championship Show

- Top 5 Horses/Riders (based on points) from each club's qualifying classes will compete
- Horses/Riders must show in 50% of their home club's shows and be in good standing
- Horses/Riders can only compete one time in each class, and as such, can only represent one club per class
- If a horse or rider qualifies in a class at more than one club, the horse/rider must declare which club they are riding for
- Trainers can show multiple qualifying horses in horse classes

2021 Arizona State Championship Show

To qualify for the AZ State Championship Show you must:

- Be a member in good standing with any one of three clubs.
- Horses/Riders must show in 50% of their home club's completed shows (home club may be declared at the end of the year). The same is true for horses competing in horse classes. A trainer may show more than one time in a horse class based on qualifying horses.
- Finish in the Top 5 (based on points) of a qualifying class.

Horses and Riders can only compete one time in each class at the Championship Show, and as such, can only represent one club per class.

- If a horse or rider qualifies in a class at more than one club, the rider/horse must declare which club they are riding for at the Championship Show.

Example: Rider John Wayne rides the in \$15AM at all 3 clubs. John finishes in the Top 5 of NACHA and SACHA. John declares NACHA as the club he is riding for at the Championship Show. So, the rider sitting in 6th place at SACHA moves into 5th place (if that rider is a member of that club and competed at 50% of that clubs shows) and will compete at the Championship Show.
